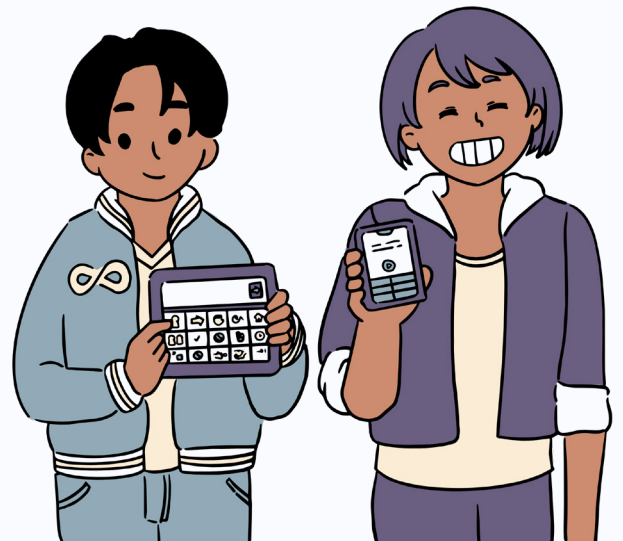
**What:** Cultural and Social Empowerment Activities
